

# New rights for Michigan **VOTERS**

## ► Register to vote through Election Day

Up to 15 days before Election	14 days prior to Election	Election Day
<b>Register at:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any Secretary of State branch office</li> <li>Your township, city or county clerk's office</li> <li>A designated state agency</li> <li>By mail</li> </ul>	<b>Register:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>In person</b> with your township or city clerk</li> </ul>	<b>Register and vote:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>In person</b> with your township or city clerk, <u>not</u> at a precinct.</li> </ul> <p>Voters who register on Election Day get a ballot and can vote that day.</p>
<div> <p><b>Residency verification required.</b></p> <p><i>Acceptable documents include:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Driver's license</li> <li>Bank statement</li> <li>Other government document</li> <li>State ID card</li> <li>Paycheck</li> <li>Government check</li> <li>Current utility bill</li> </ul> <p><i>Documents must have name and current address.</i></p> <p><i>Digital copies are acceptable.</i></p> </div>		

## ► All voters now can vote early

### Step 1: Request your ballot.

Get an application at county, township and city clerks' offices or at [Michigan.gov/Vote](https://Michigan.gov/Vote).

- Mailed-in applications must be received by **5 p.m. the Friday before an election**. Your ballot will be mailed to you.
- Voters also can drop off their application in person at their township or city clerk's office by **4 p.m. the Monday before Election Day** and get their ballot.

### Step 2: Complete it, sign it, submit it.

- Option 1:** Drop off completed ballot in person to your township or city clerk.
- Option 2:** Return your ballot through the mail.

► **Ballots must be signed and received by 8 p.m. on Election Day.**
