SCHEDULING

*Riders must be ready 15 minutes before their pickup time, and may not get picked up until 15 minutes after their pickup time depending on traffic, weather, and the daily schedule

Ex. Scheduled Pick up time is 10:30am- be ready at 10:15am. Depending on traffic, Weather, and The daily Schedule the driver has until 10:45am to pick you up

*We need your name, address, and phone number when you make a bus reservation (even if you have ridden our bus before)

*We need the name and address of the place you are going

****THERE IS A SEVEN MILE RADIUS from the Center FOR RIDES****

*Children/grandchildren (limit 2) are allowed to accompany you on the bus:
- They are at least eight years old
- You let us know when making your reservation
- There is an available seat for them after seniors have signed up
- They wear a seat belt
- They behave well

RIDING

*If you need to have a caregiver on the bus with you, you need to make a reservation for them as well, when you sign up

*Each person including their items that they bring onto the bus (walker, cart, groceries, bags, etc) MUST ONLY OCCUPY ONE SEAT so that there is enough room for everyone to sit- No spreading out to two seats

*PLEASE MOVE OVER TO ALLOW OTHERS TO SIT

*STANDARD WALKERS AND SMALL CARTS ARE ALLOWED- IF YOU BRING A CART ALL YOUR GROCERIES MUST FIT INTO IT AND THE CART MUST FIT IN FRONT OF YOUR SEAT

*CARTS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE AISLES

*AISLES MUST REMAIN CLEAR AT ALL TIMES PER SAFETY REGULATIONS

*NO CASES OF WATER OR POP OR OTHER LARGE ITEMS

*No riding of the wheelchair lifts unless you are in a wheelchair, or you have a walker with a seat

SAFETY

*We offer limited assistance when requested. We will help carry walkers down steps, carry your groceries to your front door or just inside your apartment building, and your cart onto and off the bus. However, groceries are limited to two cloth bags, or one small cart and they must not be too heavy. If we deem you need assistance beyond what we can provide, we reserve the right to require you to bring someone with you to assist you, for an additional charge.

*While masks are not required to ride, we ask that you be mindful that some passengers may have compromised immune systems. If you feel under the weather or have been around anyone who is ill, please try to stay home. If you have venture out while you are under the weather, please wear a mask.

*We reserve the right to deny service if we feel your safety or others' safety is at risk, for any reason

*We are not responsible for any missing or broken items
