

When you renew your library card, please provide proof of residency in Madison Heights, proof of attending school full time at a school in Madison Heights, or proof of working at an business address in Madison Heights.

At this time please update/verify your phone number or email so that you will continue to receive timely notices from the library. Library notices are sent to give patrons information. Type of notices and information sent include:

- **Material is overdue and fines are being charged.**
  - Notices can be received by email, phone, or U.S. mail.
- **Material has not been returned and the patron is being charged to replace the item.**
  - Notices can be received by email, phone, or U.S. mail
- **The library card is expiring and needs to be renewed.**
  - Notices can be received by email, phone, or U.S. mail
- **A requested item is available.**
  - Notices can be received by email, phone, or U.S. mail
  - Text notices are also available for requested items only [holds] Since fees may be charged by your phone provider, you must opt in for this notice. Staff cannot set this up.
- **Notices that items are due in a couple of days are available with email notices only.**

**Effective March 30, 2015:**

All Madison Heights Public Library's library cards will expire one year from the date they are issued. Cards will be renewed upon verification of current address. Outstanding fines and fees must be paid before a card will be renewed. See more information.
